This Peppercorn (*Schinus molle*) is in good condition with a full canopy and no damage to trunk or limbs. It has similar height and spread which makes it appear symmetrical. The tree makes a significant contribution to the surrounding landscape and was possibly planted in 1890 or earlier as part of the garden of 'Bronte House', the house formerly on the site before subdivision.
