The State Park extends upstream from Pound Bend along the Yarra River and the northern boundary of Wonga Park to include Mount Lofty at its eastern limit.

Within Warrandyte, the park includes Pound Bend and the River frontage upstream to 'The Island'; Black Flat Reserve, Jumping Creek Reserve and the river frontage between; Whipstick Gully; Fourth Hill; Timber Reserve

and the Common.
