What is significant?

The terrace of three dwellings at 41-45 Christmas Street, Northcote (Croxton), built for the engineer/builder and speculator, Frederick Marriott, in 1888-89.

How is it significant?

The terrace of three dwellings at 41-45 Christmas Street, Northcote (Croxton) is of local aesthetic significance to

the City of Darebin.

Why is it significant?

It is aesthetically significant (Criterion E) as a rare three dwelling terrace in this locale, comparing with the defaced terrace at nos. 66-70 Jenkins Street nearby, also built by Marriott as an investment.

Physical Description 1

A terrace of three representative single storeyed late Victorian Boom Style dwellings with party walls extended to form verandah ends and side garden walls. No. 41 is separated from nos. 43-45 by a lane. The brickwork is bichromatic and the cast iron lace ornamentation survives at no. 45, the lacework to no. 41 being presumably recent. Verandahs are convex, with the exception of the skillion to no. 41 which has been rebuilt. The parapets have been part demolished but no. 45 alone retains its balustrade and urns and consoles to the central curved pediment with shell end that survives on all three parapets.

Condition: Sound. Integrity: Medium, parapets defaced, verandahs to nos. 41 and 43 altered, no.41 extended at rear.
