

## **Statement of Significance**

Serving Manning's new Alphington Village of the 1850s, this church, like 156-158 Heidelberg Road, is an historic memorial to this early phase of Heidelberg and Northcote's development, in particular Manning's early subdivision. It has long served public gatherings in the Northcote area and is among the small number of stone buildings in the municipality. It is comparable in scale and style to the All Saints Church at 14-16 High Street (1859, qv).

# **Physical Description 1**

Designed in the style of an early English Parish Church, the Alphington Methodist Church is constructed of coursed basalt rubble, smooth-faced, with openings formed in red brickwork. Simulated plate tracery has been used on the tree light windows at the eastern end, which have stop chamfered arises are the general finish detail on the frames. 'Fancy White' brick double-header courses are used as a capping for the gable, which is topped by a crocket finial. The church interior is simple and undistinguished
