This building has local significance for its architectural interest as an excellent example of a Moderne weatherboard and cream brick structure with an angled entrance wall, and lights at the front gate posts. It was designed and constructed c1955 ([i]) by the McLean Brothers of Tasmania for Reg White, Mayor of Hamilton,
