The site has potential archaeological deposits that may provide evidence of early squatting or land selection in the Wangaratta region.

Interpretation of Site	Potentially a hut site from earliest period of occupation in the region i.e. pastoral run outstation, or a house site dating to c. 1860-1870. The lack of surface artefacts makes this difficult to interpret.

History

The site is located on the extreme boundary of the two large pastoral Runs; Oven's Crossing and Laceby. Allotment 21 was surveyed in the 1860's and advertised for sale in 1864. The land came with 200 pounds of improvements. The land around Allotment 21 was quickly alienated, however Allotment 21 remained under a grazing licence until purchased by E. Worchester in the 1890's. A 1950's topographic map indicates a house where the site was identified.
