Physical Description 1

Coburg Infant School & Shelter Shed was built in 1910 as an extension of the Coburg Primary School number 484 on the other side of Bell Street. Built of red brick. It has roughcast render details with Art Nouveau decoration

on the parapet and in the gable ends. The roof is Marseilles tiles and has special ventilators along the ridge. The interior is also substantially intact and has fine Australian carvings in the joinery.
