What is significant?

The Coburg West Primary School at 185-187 Reynard Street, Coburg, comprising only the buildings constructed in 1916-17 and 1927 fronting Reynard Street. The remainder of the school grounds are not significant.

How is it significant?

The Coburg West Primary School at 185-187 Reynard Street, Coburg is of local historic and aesthetic interest to the City of Moreland.

Why is it significant?

Of historic significance, for its association with the development of Coburg. Also, for its use as a training college, particularly for rural students and student teachers, in the mid-20th century. (AHC Criterion A.4)

Of aesthetic significance, as a good example of a substantial late Edwardian (early inter-war) primary school in the City of Moreland. (AHC Criterion E.1)

Physical Description 1

The Coburg West Primary School is a large two storey red brick building with a hipped terracotta tiled roof, with a U-shaped plan. Feature include: a defined painted rendered central entrance, painted rendered details defining the extremities of the building, the central entrance, and the separation between the ground and first floor of the building. Windows are generally double-hung sash with some feature windows. Relief lettering includes COBURG WEST SCHOOL NO 3941 and AD 1916.
