Interpretation of Site Heritage Inventory Interpretation: This site was an outstation and as such served as the residence of both shepherds and a hutkeeper. The site appears to have undergone a second phase, or to have been modified in the 1850s. It is interesting to note that 150m northeast of site, on the banks of the Fiery Creek, there is a large Aboriginal artefact scatter, comprising quartz flakes and cores.

History

Heritage Inventory History of Site: The site is part of the Campbell Brothers' Mt Cole property - the first European settlement in the region. Colin Campbell was a prominent settler, being both a member of parliament and an Honorary Correspondent (distributed rations and supplies to Aborigines). Historical records attest to Aboriginal

people camping around the property throughout the 1840s, 50s and 60s.
