St Fillan is a grazing property and a house whose garden contained 9 classified trees. The original owner was the Victorian Premier Sir James Munro, who bought it in 1880 and created the garden. The original house was an ornate wooden house, which was a guest house from 1898 to 1932. In 1937 a Georgian-style weatherboard replaced the old house.
