A cottage of stone rubble between timber posts, built in 1873 or earlier by the miner John Tyson and occupied from the 1890s by Robert Love and his family of nine in all. Its small scale and limited facilities graphically illustrate the lifestyle and accommodation of the better-off miner during the later nineteenth century and through the depression of the 1890s. The laundry and toilet annexe is a more recent addition. Classified: 16/10/1986
