This lake, which provides habitat for many water-fowl, is an attractive area for sight-seeing and picnicking. It is surrounded by forested slopes containing Peppermint (*E. radiata*) and Brittle Gum (*E. mannifera*) and the precipitous Mount Buffalo is clearly visible to the east.

LOCATION AND BOUNDARIES:

Sited on the Buffalo River, adjacent to Mount Buffalo National Park. This landscape adjoins the Classified Mount Buffalo, and extends to the surrounding mountain ridge tops and dam wall.
