A small dense stand of this rare species, endemic to Victoria, and restricted mainly to the Yarra Valley. It grows up to 20 metres in height and has fibrous bark. This stand is protected in the roadside reserve, with most trees in good condition and a number of young trees in the understorey. The Council has erected a sign noting the species and its rarity.

These 50 trees are located in a roadside reserve 500m west of Traralgon-Maffra Road.
