A tree outstanding for its large height, trunk circumference or canopy spread.

A tree that is an outstanding example of its species.

A large spreading tree near a major entrance to the Gardens. The tree is the largest known of this species in

cultivation and dominates the shrubbery. The tree is a very attractive specimen and has a well developed framework.

This tree is located near the corner of Blessington & Tennyson Streets.
