This is an attractive specimen of *Eucalyptus camaldulensis* in good condition and located on the east side of Collins Street approximately 14 metres from the highway.  
On the south-eastside of the trunk is a shield shaped scar measuring 1.25m long x 0.4m wide sited just above ground level.
