Rare or localised.

Outstanding size

This is a very large specimen of a species rare in cultivation. Other known examples occur at Bendigo, Malmsbury, Eastern Park, Geelong, Warrnambool, and the Royal Botanic Gardens. The species has a very restricted distribution (about 3000 trees) in the wild and occurs in two small areas on Santa Rosa Island and the San Diego Coast, United States. *P. torreyana* is currently being tested as a plantation tree for use in Australia, New Zealand and Kenya
