Tree which occurs in a unique location or context and so provides a contribution to an historic garden or park;  
Outstanding Size

At the eastern end in playground area A well-rounded mature specimen located in a passive recreation area. Although cultivated more widely in Northern Australia, this species is uncommon in cultivation in Victoria. (Previously known as *Angophora cordifolia*). Some formative pruning is required and the picnic table should be relocated away from the root zone to alleviate the continuing compaction of the soil.
