## Statement of Significance

Last updated on - December 1, 2004

### What is significant?

The house, constructed c.1915, at 22 Radovick Street, Korumburra.

### How is it significant?

The dwelling at 22 Radovick Street is of local historic and aesthetic interest to the town of Korumburra.

### Why is it significant?

Aesthetically, it is a good example of a Federation timber villa that contributes to the historic streetscape

character of Radovick Street. (Criterion E)

## Physical Description 1

No. 22 Radovick Street is a single storey Federation Queen Anne villa with a corrugated iron roof. The front garden contains a large Copper Beech (*Fagus Slyratice*).

The house features rusticated boards and a bay window on the exterior. Internal features include timber ceilings of dark pine as well as a pine dado and heshen lined wallpaper in the entry foyer and dining room.
