What is significant?

"Killeen House", constructed c.1933, at 12-14 Bair Street, Leongatha.

Why is it significant?

"Killeen House" at 12-14 Bair Street, Leongatha is of local historic and aesthetic interest to the town of Leongatha.

Historically, it is one of a group of buildings that demonstrate the important commercial development of that occurred in Leongatha during the interwar years.

Aesthetically, it is a substantial brick interwar shop that contributes to the historic streetscape of Bair Street.
