History

Heritage Inventory History of Site: This road is now known as Malmsbury Post Office Road, and also as Elphinstone Access Road. However, the accounts of the Lausiston and Edgecombe District Road Board do not record any money spent on a road with either of these names, although most of the names recorded in these accounts are no longer used today. It is likely, however, that this road dates to the early days of Malmsbury. The earliest cadastral plans show this road extending north to meet with a road that ran from Elphinstone to the Barfold diggings during the 1850s and 1860s. Today the road ends approximately 800 metres south-east of the "Limestone" property. This road would have provided access to several houses that are now abandoned.
