#### **History**

Heritage Inventory History of Site: Trogisch Reef, near German Gully, was opened in 1860. The reef receives little mention by the mining register, except for a reference in July 1861 to prospectors getting a kiln of quartz ready. The archaeological records suggests that the kilns on the site were associated with a battery. Old German reef, is the next reef south of Trogisch's (other side of gully). The mining register in December 1860 records that a site for a machinery dam and tramway had been granted for this reef.
