Interpretation of Site

The township was surveyed in 1874 into 227 lots, but only 20 were taken up. The township boasted four hotels, blacksmith, baker, shoemaker, school and police reserve. In 1883 the town was 'moved' to Mitiamo, 3,5 km, to the west, due to the construction of the new railway.

Archaeological Significance

The site provides a unique opportunity to study artefacts from 1874-1883. One artefact scatter was located corresponding to the location of a hotel. Poor visibility limited the assessment of the site boundary size.
