### Interpretation of Site

Heritage Inventory Interpretation: The site is extremely fragmented and eroded and difficult to interpret from surface features. The bluestone and cement ford is possibly the remains of a ford present as a river crossing before the construction of the freeway, the ceramics and bottle glass appear to be derived from a deposit destroyed by construction of a vehicle track, the cobbled surface exposed at a depth of 0.20cm maybe the remains of a road. Probably not a contact site - artefacts from an Aboriginal campsite appear to be mixed and distributed with other materials.
