Heritage Inventory History of Site: The Bushy Park Run was one of the earliest pastoral leases in the Dandenong

Valley. After changing hands several times the Pre-emptive Right by J. Delaney in the 1850's. Much of the surrounding land was granted under the early ? settlement acts in the 1870's.
