## **Physical Description 2**

A significant Moderne style parapeted fabade, with wrought iron and heeler brick detailing and manganese base, comparable on a small scale with the contemporary and award winning Second Church of Christ Scientist Church, Camberwell. Historically & socially significant (see also adjoining parts of complex).

`This symmetrical cuboid brick building constructed with a plain dark brick ground floor and piano nobile first floor which is divided into vertical bays, by large simple areas of glass, which are recessed behind the plane of dark brick vertical piers and surrounds. The Israelite Church Hall has social significance as one of several religious buildings in this part of Fitzroy. It is distinguished in its own right as a religious building designed in the Inter War Stripped Classical style. The style was more commonly used for large office buildings, particularly for government departments and occasionally for funery buildings.' (Wight 2001-2)
