History

Heritage Inventory History of Site: Site originally part of Noorilim Run of 1840's (Pre-emptive Right purchased by W Webster 1856). Area resumed for closer settlement c. 1870 with site block comprising section 14 and 15 selected 25/11/1874 by Theodore Tidboald. Ruin evidently was a small roadside inn predating selection. Inn may have served early crossing place on the Goulburn River.
