History

Heritage Inventory History of Site: The Forests Commission of Victoria estanblished the first state mill when it purchased the Nayook Sawmilling Company in 1918. This one opened a few years later. The sawmill operated until 1939 and was thereafter used by a lone and reclusive man, Sid Bennett. He died in the early 1960s and, in recent years the huts have been partially modernised and used by Scout groups.
