## History

Heritage Inventory History of Site: A two foot gauge steam tramway from Alexandra to Lower Rubicon was built by the Rubicon KLmber and tramway Company Pty Ltd and opened in December 1912. A Lower Rubicon (the Depot) it connected with the 3'6" gauge horse tramway serving Clark and Kidd's sawmill in the forest. The 2 footgauge Alexandra line was extended to Tin Hut by the SEC in 1926.
