History

Heritage Inventory History of Site: As the areas of forest were cut out, the log hauling winches were moved out further from the mills they served. Clark & Pearce's No 1 mill, founded in 1906, was the earliest mill in the Rubicon Forest. This winch and boiler were used previously at other sites and this was their final resting place, circa 1939.
