History

Heritage Inventory History of Site: The mill was shifted to this location, from near Buxton, in 1938. Two log lines were built to serve the mil. Sawn timber was transferred several hundred metres via an outlet tramway to a loading gantry where it was loaded on to motor truck. The area was cut out by 1951 and the mill was closed.
