Heritage Inventory History of Site: The mill was operating in 1940 with a 3' gauge, well constructed tramway extending over 2 kilometres along Storm Creek. The mill was steam powered. Prior to October 1955 the mill was owned by William Cook. It changed hands in 1955, but the closure date is not known.
