History

Heritage Inventory History of Site: Copper mining activity at Cooper's Creek initially resulted in the development of limeworks nearby, as lime was required as a flux in the smelting process. However, once the Erica Walhalla rail link was constructed early this century, the lime quarries were able to reach a wider market, with the Platina railway station established as a transport outlet.
