File note: Erected in 1906 to replace an earlier lightship, the Gellibrand Pile Light was struck by the *Melbourne Trader* on the 21st June 1976. As it had become a shipping hazard it set alight and burnt by the Public Works Department on the 23rd June 1976.

The Public Works Department subsequently salvaged, restored and donated the top section to the Melbourne Maritime Museum.
