### **History**

Heritage Inventory History of Site:

Reedy Creek, at this point, would have first been worked in 1852-3 and then intensively throughout the 1850s - 60s. In the late 1880s, the mining surveyor wrote of a large-scale operation in progress on Reid's/Reedy Creek: 'Much of Reid's Creek Valley has been washed down to the bed rock, and removed by the Excelsior Company. They are steadily advancing towards the falls at the upper end of the valley, and, by the time they have finished, there will be scarcely a trace of gold left in this once fabulously rich locality.'
