## History

Heritage Inventory History of Site: In 1906-7, the Crooked River Dredging Co. erected a barge-mounted dredge (ex-Omeo) to work a lease near the junction of Good Hope and Jungle creeks. The plant dredged an extent of three miles, from Winchester to Good Hope Creek. The last ground worked was in the neighbourhood of Talbotville in 1912, after which the dredge was removed to Tongio West.
