History

Heritage Inventory History of Site: The Upper Dargo River was worked by alluvial miners from as early as the 1850s right through to the turn of the century and beyond. For much of its mining history, the alluvial ground at the Upper Dargo was largely populated by Chinese diggers. No record was found concerning this diversion sluice or any undertaking of its kind.
