Heritage Inventory History of Site: No reference has been found to the Cambridge mine or battery. The Rising Sun mine had steam-powered plant as early as 1871, and the Royal Albert Co. had an 8-hp portable engine powering its battery at Bonang River in 1889. Other plants of that period were water-powered. [Jack Mustard book?]
