#### What is significant?

This property has been reviewed as part of the Stawell Main Street Precinct in 2024, and its heritage category is now Non-contributory.

## How is it significant?

The property is Non-contributory to the precinct.

## Why is it significant?

Text from the 2004 heritage study:

The building at 110 Main Street, Stawell, is **historically** and **architecturally** significant at a **CONTRIBUTORY** level. Although the main facade and shopfront have been greatly altered, the rear two storey hipped roof form clad in galvanised corrugated iron and the early brick parapet walls (but not the extended brown brick section) contribute to the historical and architectural amenity of the area.
