The double fronted timber residence at 67 Gawler Street was erected c.1881 for Charles Robinson. The house *is* typically conceived and incorporates distinctive timber decoration including the gable bargeboard and pinnacle, pediment motif to main window and verandah posts and valance. The house *is* a fine example of its style in Portland.
