The substantial double storey stone mansion "Claremont" was erected 1852 - 53 by Stephen Henty for his brother Francis to rent. The house is among the largest in the town and notable for its association with the Henty family. The original slate roof has been replaced and the verandah is a poor reproduction of the original. The house is simply conceived and austere decorated. The rear stone stable make an interesting group with the house.
