Archaeological Significance

Due to the presence of the intact remains, it is highly likey that further intact structured remains and associated occupation deposits will be preserved here.

Historical Significance Hallenstein Tannery stood here from the mid 19th Century and expanded significantly between 1910 and 1952. Hallenstein tannery is an important early industry representing the noxious industries for which Footscray became well known.
