Interpretation of Site	Site appears to have been occupied by farmers in the mid 20th century, and later abandoned/removed/destroyed. Eastern side of Toolern Creek has been used recently for stock grazing. Currently unused, with proposals to create a public park.
Archaeological Significance	Some potential (low to moderate) for subsurface deposits to exist in addition to surface remains. Archaeological deposits will potentially provide information on mid 20th century European occupation of the area. Low archaeological significance.
Historical Significance	Historically significant regarding mid 20th century European occupation in the local area, which appears to confirm historical documentation.
