WASHINGTON BLOCK CLAIM

WASHINGTON COMPANY (March 1861)

12.1859: claim taken up following the discovery of a new lead running through the Croesus Co.'s claim.

03.1861: reported the discovery of a tributary lead running into their claim and obtained an extension of their ground under the mining regulations; making about 10 pounds per man per week.

06.1861: generally getting £5 to £10 pounds per week.

07.1861: doing very well; discovered a new lead while working their claim and have applied for an additional claim.

08.1861: paying moderately.

09.1861: getting from £6 to £10 per man.

10.1861: have struck a fresh gutter and are getting from £6 to £10 per week.

11.1861: struck a new lead coming into their claim from the Carngham direction and have taken out a new claim; three other companies have also taken out claims.

12.1861: have not got any gold yet.
