# **Physical Description 1**

Were Street is oriented north-south, situated immediately south of Montmorency Station. The street is lined on both sides with shops, predominantly single-storey but some two-storey. Characteristic of the post-war period, buildings are of cream brick construction, many with original cantilevered awnings and shopfronts.
