# **Physical Description 1**

This intact turn of the century timber house is of interest for the heavy cast iron decoration in a fern pattern to the verandah, the timber fernery to the rear and the recessed door surround in panelled wood. The effect is marred by the incompatible aluminium screen door. This corner building is an intrinsic part of the streetscape.
