The main section of the house consists of transverse gables ,which terminate in ornate timber barge boards, fretwork panels with trefoil designs and turned timber finials. The street facade is of the type found on many cottages with. a central door and flanking windows. The verandah has an ornate frieze incorporating a fan type pattern with central drop

pendants and supported on fan patterned brackets.
