## **Physical Description 1**

This timber house is interesting for its unusual facade with two bay windows and awkward rectangular canopy over the arched entranceway. The bay window lights are divided by slender timber columns supporting a plain frieze which may have had decoration removed. The combination of unusual details on an essentially plain house makes this building of interest as part of the character of Ballarat.
