The fake timber ashlar fronted house is of importance for the veranda iron. This flat cast iron frieze and post pattern appears to be unique to Ballarat and the few remaining examples are worthy of retention, The house itself is a simple cottage with a projecting gable with a three light window surmounted by an ornate timber gable decoration.
