Physical Description 1

This ornate timber Victorian villa is of interest for the three light bay windows ornate cast iron verandah decoration, and elaborate parapet. The intact parapet rises above the verandah line with a frieze of rectangular panels with three medallions in each. Above this is a cornice supported on paired dentils with decorations between. The parapet had intact urns at each corner and an elaborate pediment of two squat pedestals supporting foliage motif with consoles on either side of the name plate surmounted by an organically inspired decorative motif.
