This substantial intact house is of interest for its elaborate return verandah and fine polychrome brickwork.

The house, on bluestone footings, is of red brick with cream brick quoin work and door surrounds, chimney decoration and chequer board patterned decoration above the vernadah line. The house is of elegant proportions and is enhanced by a verandah on three sides. The verandah is supported by slender cast iron, columns with Corinthian capitals and a cast iron frieze of unusual pattern with cruciform pendants alternating large and small. The centre of each span is marked by a pendant drop.
